LOCATION AND DIVISION: Department of Lands & Natural Resources (Invasive Species Division), Rota

DUTIES:

Development & implementation of CRB monitoring systems which may include pheromone trapping & damage surveys. Development & implementation of control tactics. Preparation of progress reports required by federal grants which fund the program. Collect & analyze biological data & specimens. Study the characteristics of Coconut Rhino Beetle including reproduction, population dynamics & movement pattern. Estimate, monitor & manage coconut rhino beetle population. Develop management strategies & methodology for containment, suppression & eventual eradication of coconut rhinoceros beetle. Fostering partnership with regional scientist involved in coconut rhino beetle field experientment. To assist the Invasive Species Coordinator in implementing the CNMI strategic Action Plan for all Invasive Species. Coordinate & work closely with the CRB Field staff in Rota. Perform other related duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Masters Degree in entomology, plus four (4) years of experience in insect control work or closely related area. Must possess a valid motor vehicle operator's license. Copy of degree or official transcript & police clearance must be attached to the application.
