Patrols to fishing and hunting sites on foot, in auto and boat during regular and irregular working hours. Executes warrants of arrest, serves subpoenas and conducts related arrest procedures. Operates boats, vehicles, and related gear. Conducts land and water surveys for biological data collecting. Performs other related duties as assigned.

Plus, two (2) years of experience in the investigation and enforcement work pertaining to fish and wildlife and must successfully complete the police academy.
